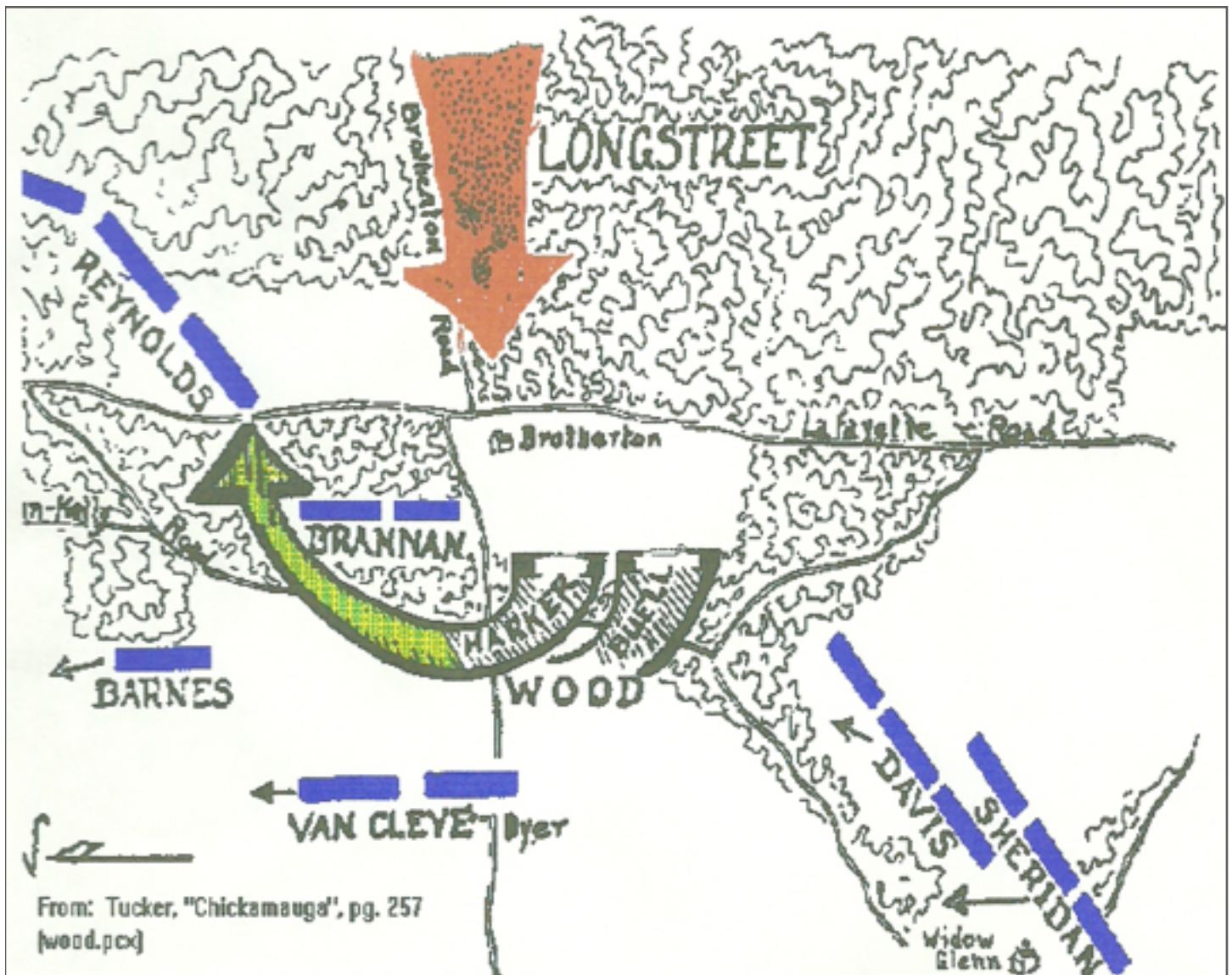


PRINT THIS MAP AND BRING TO SEPTEMBER MEETING

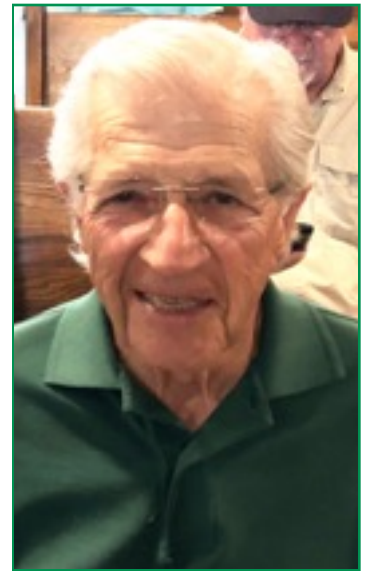
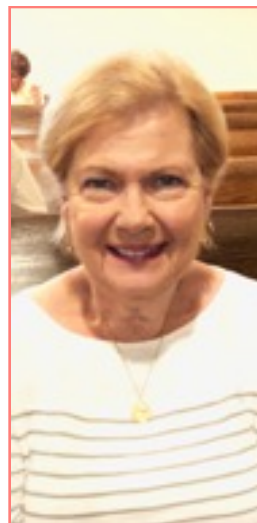
Be sure to check the Sutler's Table. Over the summer we received some really fine books as donations. There are over 100 new titles.

Those are the summer happenings. See you at our September 4 meeting!

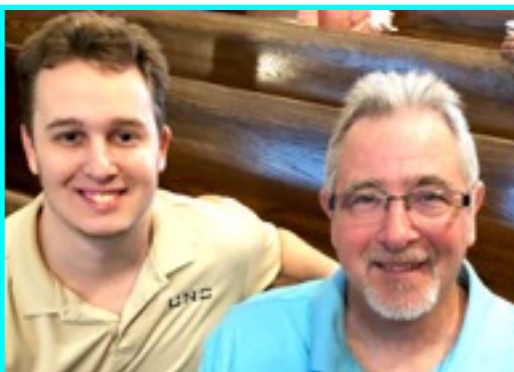
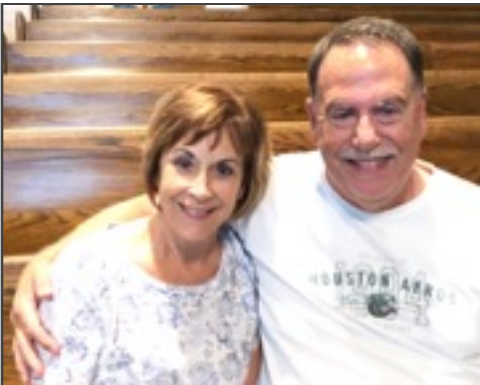
